Philip Essenmacher, Worth Township Supervisor, appeared before the board to discuss the upcoming Mill Creek bridge replacement on M-25 in Worth Township. This project is slated to start on August 22, 2016 and be completed in November of 2016. MDOT's designated detour route is Galbraith Line Rd to Wildcat Rd to M-90. Worth Township Officials are concerned that local traffic will not follow the designated detour route and will use local roadways such as Burnsline Rd, Baker Road and Babcock Road. The Road Commission has prepared an estimate for road improvements on Burnsline Rd, Baker Rd and Babcock Rd. Worth Township states they cannot afford the costs necessary to have these improvements performed and requested the Road Commission incur the costs. Comments were received from local agencies which will be affected by the detour. The Road Commission Board will take the information provided under advisement.

Terry O'Connor, Minden Township Supervisor, presented the Road Commission Board a request for a traffic study to be performed on Palms Road between Rangeline Road and South Minden Road in Minden Township. This study is requested so that a speed limit may be established in the designated area.
